- _____ At least 17 years of age
- _____ Able to read, speak, write and understand English language
- _____ Logbook endorsement or equivalent to take FAA written test
- _____ Passed FAA written test
- _____ Received flight training and logbook endorsement on areas listed in FAR 61.107(b)
- _____ Logged at least 40 hours of total flight time
- _____ Logged at least 20 hours of dual received flight training, which must include:
 - _____ 3 hours of cross-country flight training in a single-engine airplane
 - _____ 3 hours of night flight training in a single-engine airplane, which must include:
 - _____ One night cross-country flight over 100 nautical miles total distance
 - _____ 10 take-offs and 10 full-stop landings with every take-off and landing involving flight in a traffic pattern
 - _____ 3 hours of instrument training in an aircraft (not a simulator)
 - _____ 3 hours of training in preparation for the practical test within 60 days of the test
- _____ Logged at least 10 hours of solo flight time, which must include:
 - _____ 5 hours of solo cross-country flight time
 - _____ One solo cross-country flight of at least 150 nautical miles total distance with full-stop landings at a minimum of 3 points, with one segment of the flight consisting of a straight line distance of at least 50 nautical miles between take-off and landing locations
 - _____ 3 take-offs and 3 full-stop landings at an airport with a control tower
